NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE APPLICATION FOR NEW LICENSE

Unequivocal Statement of Intent.

Placer County Water Agency intends to file an application for a new license for the Project utilizing the Commission's Integrated Licensing Process.

Type of Principal Works Licensed:

The Project consists of a series of two large dams and principal storage reservoirs (French Meadows and Hell Hole), two smaller dams and regulating reservoirs (Middle Fork Interbay and Ralston Afterbay), three small dams and diversion pools (South Fork Long Canyon, North Fork Long Canyon and Duncan Creek), five tunnels, five powerhouses (French Meadows, Hell Hole, Middle Fork, Ralston and Oxbow) and associated powerline and ancillary facilities.

Location of the Project (By State, County, and Stream):

The Project facilities are located in the Middle Fork American River watershed, at elevations ranging from approximately 5,300 feet to approximately 1,100 feet. All Project facilities are located in Placer County except a portion of the Ralston Afterbay Dam which is located in El Dorado County, California. The French Meadows Reservoir is located near the Granite Chief Wilderness at the headwaters of the Middle Fork

American River. Water impounded in French Meadows Reservoir (which includes water diverted from Duncan Creek) is conveyed through the 2.6-mile French Meadows-Hell Hole Tunnel to French Meadows Powerhouse and released to Hell Hole Reservoir which is located on the Rubicon River. Hell Hole Reservoir also impounds water from the upper reaches of the Rubicon River, a major tributary that flows into the Middle Fork American River at a much lower elevation. Located at the outflow of Hell Hole Dam, the small Hell Hole Powerhouse generates power as water is released through the dam to the river below. From Hell Hole Reservoir, water is transported through the 10.4-mile Hell Hole-Middle Fork Tunnel to the Middle Fork Powerhouse. Diversions from South Fork Long Canyon and North Fork Long Canyon contribute to flow in this tunnel and can augment storage in Hell Hole Reservoir. Water is released from the Middle Fork Powerhouse into Middle Fork Interbay, which serves as a diversion pool for the intake to the 6.7 mile Middle Fork-Ralston Tunnel. Water is transported through this tunnel to the Ralston Powerhouse, from which it is released into Ralston Afterbay. Water moves through this afterbay into the 0.08 mile Ralston-Oxbow Tunnel and then to the Oxbow Powerhouse. From the Oxbow Powerhouse, water is released into the Middle Fork American River approximately 29 miles upstream from Folsom Reservoir.

Installed Plant Capacity:

The total nameplate generating capacity of the Project is 223.7 megawatts. Nameplate generating capacity of the Project powerhouses is as follows:

French Meadows Powerhouse -----15.3 MW

Hell Hole Powerhouse ----- 0.7 MW

Middle Fork Powerhouse -----122.4 MW

Ralston Powerhouse ----- 79.2 MW Oxbow Powerhouse ----- 6.1 MW
