⁴**Information Needs:** Data necessary to fully evaluate potential Project effects on environmental and cultural resources and develop potential license conditions that balance resource interests.
⁵**Technical Studies:** Information gathering and analysis designed to evaluate the potential effects of the Project on environmental and cultural resources.
